Dear McCollum Park Visitors and Area Residents,

In June 2009, the Downers Grove Park District held a public meeting at the McCollum Park picnic shelter, to discuss the need to renovate aging park components and other proposed improvements at McCollum Park. During the summer of 2010, the Park District hired a land surveyor to complete a topographic survey of the entire park, and in September 2010 the District hired an engineering consultant to begin designing the infrastructure renovations at McCollum Park.

Given the number of visitors who utilize the park's recreational amenities, and the importance of this park to the neighborhood and the entire Downers Grove community; the Park District would like to provide an additional opportunity to view and comment on the plans that are in progress. A Public Open House Meeting will be held to display the park renovation designs and discuss the proposed improvements.

The Public Open House Meeting will be held from 6:30 - 8:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, February 8, 2011**, in Room 503 of the Lincoln Community Center, located at 935 Maple Avenue.
