Summer **CAMP**

TRADITIONAL FULL-DAY CAMPS, EARLY CHILDHOOD CAMPS, NATURE CAMPS AND MUSEUM CAMPS

REGISTRATION INFORMATION/DEADLINE

- Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis beginning March 14 at 9:00am for Park District residents and March 21 at 9:00am for non-residents.
- Registration deadline is the Wednesday prior to each week of camp or until the camp fills to the maximum number of participants.
- Registration is available online at www.dgparks.org or in person at the Lincoln Center or Recreation Center.

CAMP WAITLISTS

- A limited number of waitlisted spots will be available per camp session. If you are unable to secure a spot in a camp or on a waitlist, please check back online regularly to see if a camp spot or a waitlisted spot has become available.
- If your camper is waitlisted and a spot becomes available, you will receive notification from the Park District.

AGE/GRADE REQUIREMENTS

- Age/Grade requirements have been set based on the age appropriateness of the camp activities and camp structure.
- For camps that are based on grade level, the participant must be ENTERING that grade to participate in the camp.

FULL-DAY CAMP PAYMENT PLAN OPTION

- Take advantage of our convenient payment plan offered to campers enrolled in full-day camps such as Kinder Camp, Adventure Camp, Teen Trekkers and Teen Wilderness Explorers.
- When selecting this option, upon registration, you will be charged a \$20 payment for each week of camp, a \$5 payment per each week of before care and a \$5 payment for each week of after care. The remainder of the fees will be processed automatically using the credit card you used when enrolling in each session.
- If choosing the payment plan option, the automatic payment process will take place on May 16 for June camp sessions 1 to 3; June 15 for camp sessions 4 to 6; and July 15 for camp sessions 7 to 10.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

- Cancellation/refund requests must be made at least 5 days prior to the start of a camp session in order to qualify for a full refund.
- Any refund requests received less than 5 days prior to the start of a camp session will only be approved if accompanied by a doctor's note due to a medical reason.
- Self-cancellation prior to the deadline can be done online through your account or you can visit <https://www.dgparks.org/request-a-refund> to complete a refund request form.
- No refunds will be given for missed camp days unless cancelled by the Park District.

PARENT COMMUNICATION

- Parents will receive a "Welcome to Camp" email by May 27 with general camp information and reminders.
- Following the initial communication, each camp will be emailed by the Friday prior to each session with specific camp information for the upcoming week.

CAMPER INFORMATION/ EMERGENCY FORMS

- New for 2022, the Downers Grove Park District will be utilizing ePACT for camper information/emergency forms.
- Within 1 week of your camp registration, you should receive an email from ePACT to set up an account and complete your camper's electronic information/emergency forms.
- The information/emergency forms must be completed no later than the Wednesday prior to a camp session and you only need to fill out the forms once regardless of how many camps your child is enrolled in.
- If your camper is enrolled in a program that is currently using the ePACT system, you only need to update your child's information if something has changed.
- Your camper will not be allowed to attend camp until the information/emergency forms are completed.

WHAT TO WEAR

- Comfortable clothing that can get muddy, wet and messy
- Closed toed shoes/boots with socks
- Sunscreen already applied
- Nature Camps: all of the above PLUS insect repellent already applied and a hat is recommended

FRIEND REQUESTS

- A friend request form will be available online beginning May 2 at www.dgparks.org/summercamps.
- Friend requests will only be considered if submitted online between May 2 and 9:00am the Wednesday prior to a camp session.
- Friend requests are not guaranteed. Recreation Supervisors have the final determination in camp group formations.

SAFETY TOWN

Safety Town is a nationally recognized safety education program presented by the Downers Grove Police Department, Downers Grove Junior Woman's Club, Downers Grove Park District and teen volunteers. A mini safety town, complete with kid-sized buildings, street signs and sidewalks, provides an environment where children learn pedestrian, passenger and at home safety. Children ride big wheel trikes and enjoy visits by local school bus and fire department staff, while learning bike, school bus and fire safety lessons. On the last day of each session, children will receive a certificate and share their learning experience. Each child receives an official Safety Town T-shirt and class picture. A detailed program outline is provided prior to the start of the program.

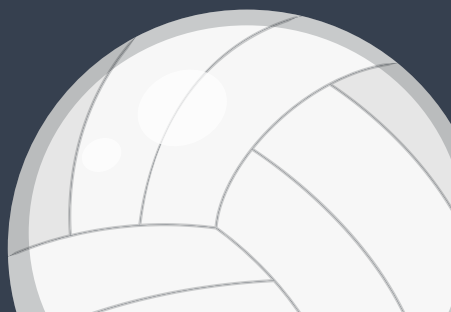
